Parenting Classes

Systematic Training for Effective Parenting (S.T.E.P)

Parents learn how to develop long-term goals for effective parenting, age appropriate child behaviors, cooperation and discipline, how to develop their child's self-esteem and confidence, plus how to emotionally support themselves as parents.

Seven (7) weekly classes: 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.

When Families Get Angry (WFGA)

Parents learn constructive methods to handle anger and how to identify their triggers. Topics include learning where anger begins, recognizing different styles of anger, expressing anger appropriately, and effective communication.

Three (3) weekly classes: 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.

Juvenile Justice Parenting Program (JJPP)

Parents and teens learn new techniques and communication skills for teens to overcome at-risk behaviors to deter court involvement. Topics include anger management, peer pressure, shoplifting, curfew violation, truancy, drug use, disorderly conduct and disrespectful behaviors.

Adult Class: Eight (8) weeks, 7:00 - 9:00 p.m.

Teen Class: Seven (7) weeks, 5:30 - 6:30 p.m.
