## APPX Service-Learning Project Proposal

This service-learning project is needed to educate students at North Stafford High School on how serious hunger affects millions of people across the world. Along with educating, this project will promote teen involvement in helping these poor-stricken communities and gain students to participate in Freerice.com and other community organizations. With this students could become more interested in participating in local, national, and international projects to improve our world. There are plenty of statistics highlighting how massive world hunger is today.

- 842 million people in the world do not have enough to eat; this number has fallen by 156 million since 1990
- The vast majority of hungry people (827 million) live in developing countries, where 14.3 percent of the population is undernourished
- Asia has the largest share of the world's hungry people (around 552 million) but the trend is downward
- If women farmers had the same access to resources as men, the number of hungry in the world could be reduced by up to 150 million
- Poor nutrition causes nearly half (45%) of deaths in children under five, which equates to 3.1 million children each year
- One out of six children -- roughly 100 million -- in developing countries is underweight, while one in four of the world's children are experiencing stunted growth; in developing countries the proportion can rise to one in three
- 80 percent of the world's stunted children live in just 20 countries
- 66 million primary school-age children attend classes hungry across the developing world, with 23 million in Africa alone
- The World Food Program calculates that \$3.2 billion is needed per year to reach all 66 million hungry school-age children.
