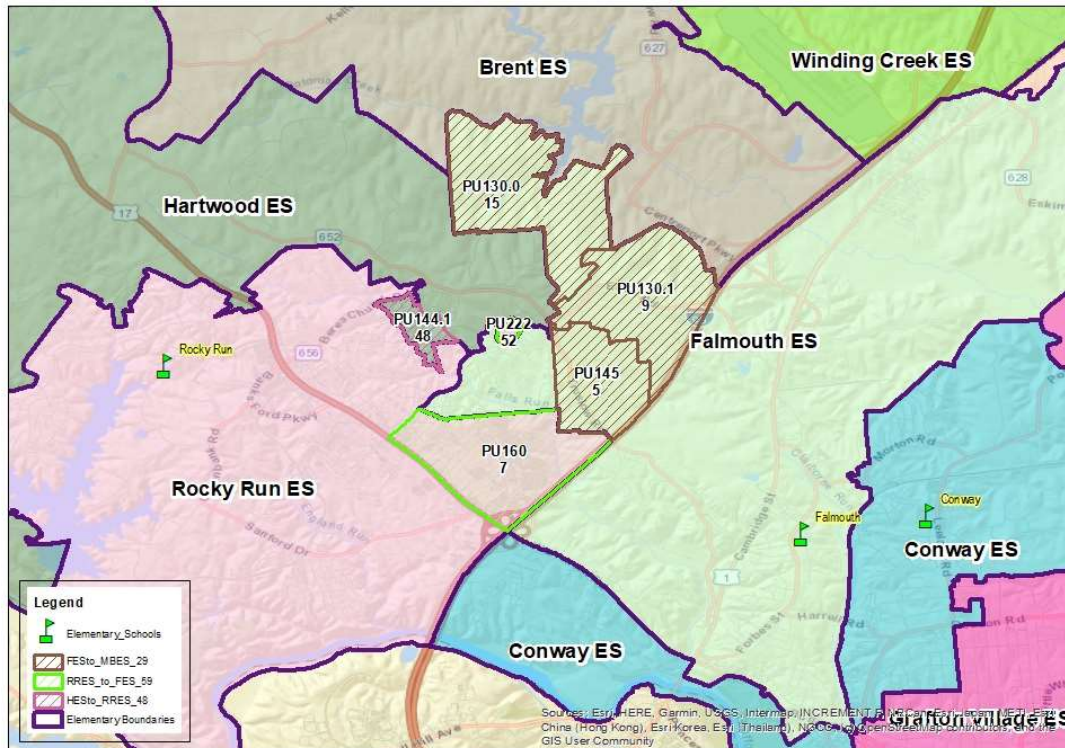


Hartwood ES Boundary Change Scenario B



Note: Elementary school enrollment totals are based on the September 30, 2021 official count. Map prepared in February 2022 by SCPS Planning & GIS

Highlights:

- Scenario redistributes enrollment among 4 schools (Brent, Falmouth, Hartwood, and Rocky Run)
- Reassigns 3 planning units (29+/- students) from Falmouth to Brent, 2 planning units (59+/- students) from Rocky Run to Falmouth, and 1 planning unit (48+/- students) from Hartwood to Rocky Run.
- Next year, (with reassignments) Brent (92%), Hartwood (98%), and Falmouth (97%) are slated to be under-capacity, while Rocky Run (107%) has a deficit of 59+/- seats (not including 4 relocatable classrooms).
- Five years after boundary change Brent (103%) is at-capacity, while Hartwood (110%) and Falmouth (115%) are slated to be over-capacity, and Rocky Run (108%) slated for a deficit of 65+/- seats (not including 4 relocatable classrooms).
- No significant change to demographic balance

Subdivisions Slated for Reassignment:

Portion of Butterfield, Chapel View, Estates of Truslow, Freeway MHP, Woods of Abel Lake, Portion of Staffordshire, Portion of England Run North, TH of England Run North, Will Morgan Farm, Williams Estates.
