

Rappahannock River Clean-up

Reminder: Your student has signed up to participate in our annual Rappahannock River Clean-up to be held on October 13, from 9:00 – 12:00. Please remember that as this is a voluntary activity for student' service hours, transportation is not provided. We invite parents to also attend as chaperons, so if you have an opportunity to do so *IT WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED*. Please see below for more information and directions to the site for our clean-up - Falmouth Beach, Fredericksburg:

- **Date: October 13, from 9:00 – 12:00** (we will run rain or shine, but not in dangerous weather such as tornadic activity, flood, or hurricane conditions). Please see the NJHS website for a Friday night update **IF THE WEATHER LOOKS SEVERE**.
- **Location:** Falmouth Beach. There is a large parking area there for drop-off.
- **Details:** Students will gather at 9:00 in the parking lot and be divided into groups based on the number of chaperons. Dress for the weather: It is always cooler by the river, and we will be there long before we reach the high for the day. As a rule of thumb, wear one more layer than you would normally. In warm weather, it is suggested to wear long pants and sun block. **Wear close-toed shoes – no flip-flops or sandals.**
- **Pick-up:** Please pick up students promptly at 12:00.

Directions to Falmouth Beach:

- From I-95 Take exit 133A to merge onto US-17 BUS S/Warrenton Rd toward Falmouth (toward Falmouth Bridge).
- Turn right onto Washington Street (about half-way down the hill near the retirement home - if you miss it, take a right onto Rt 1, followed by a quick right before you reach the bridge).
- Turn right onto W. Cambridge Street, followed by a quick left - follow the road as it changes to King Street (known by locals as *River Road*).
- The beach and parking area are on the right!
