- Welcome to the Focus Program at Rodney Thompson Middle School! The administration, staff, & Focus teacher are very excited to work with you & your student!

How does the program meet the needs of the students?

- While we are not teamed, our students will be clustered with similar-ability students who are also gifted, while also working with students of other interests & abilities.

How are students serviced & what types of services are provided?

- Our Focus Program involves a variety of unique experiences for students both inside of the regular classroom & out. The classroom teachers & Focus teacher work collaboratively to differentiate learning activities in a way that motivates & challenges your child. Students may also participate in asynchronous learning through the Focus Canvas site that will be designed to help our students grow metacognitively while enhancing their growth mindset & leadership abilities. Additionally, as much as possible, we will seek programs offered in the virtual environment for students to complete / take part in extracurricular opportunities designed to expand their thinking & creativity. Finally, students will be asked to submit a project for consideration at the Middle School Focus Showcase to be held in the spring.

Focus Services for 2021-2022

The Focus teacher provides services at each grade-level. The Focus teacher will...

- ♦ Work with each student's PLC to provide extensions & enrichment for classroom activities that are designed to meet higher level thought operations & depth.
- ◆ Monitor progress & communicate with families regarding student' progress in the classroom (when necessary) & provide emotional support for our student when in need of counsel.
- ♦ Create and / or provide information about meaningful opportunities for enrichment.
- ◆ Provide office hours for and / or counsel Focus students & parents (as needed / requested).
- ◆ Provide professional development on compacting / extending the curriculum / multiple menu options / identification (etc...) for staff.
