Scholarships: The Air Force JROTC Instructors can recommend cadets for college ROTC scholarships—any ROTC program, Army, Navy. Instructors will also assist with military academy applications as well as applications for any colleges and any other scholarship applications. ROTC scholarships include tuition, fees, books plus a monthly stipend and are available at over 800 colleges and universities nation-wide. Military academy appointments cover all expenses and a service commitment is incurred. Upon graduation, ROTC and military academy cadets are commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the armed forces.

Military Credit: Students who successfully complete 2 or 3 years of AFJROTC and enlist in any branch of the military may enter at a higher pay grade (E-2 or E-3), that is, an immediate higher rank and a higher pay rate.
