

1st Tardy to class: Warning

2nd Tardy to class: Warning/Parent Notification

3rd Tardy to class: 1 hour after school detention served in detention room/Parent Notification/Parking pass suspended 5 school days

4th Tardy to class: 2 hr after school detention served in detention room/Parent Notification/Parking pass suspended 10 school days

5th Tardy to class: 1 day of In-School Suspension Program (ISSP)/Parent Notification/ Parking pass suspended 15 school days

6th Tardy to class: 1 day of Saturday School/Parent Notification/ Parking pass suspended 20 school days
