#### Program Overview

- Emergency Medical Technician I
  - 1 credit (1 class block meeting for two periods every X or Y day for first semester)
- Emergency Medical Technician II
  - 1 credit (1 class block meeting for two periods every X or Y day for second semester)
- Emergency Medical Technician III
  - 1 credit (1 class block meeting for one period every X or Y day for the year)

#### **Program Overview**

- Social Security Number
- Immunization Records
  - Negative drug screen
- Student must be 16 years of age by the first day of the course
- CPR certification required prior to start of course
- Students will devote time outside of the scheduled course period to participate in related activities occurring in the evening and on weekends. Students will be on an ambulance at times.
- Program is governed by the VA Office of Emergency Medical Services



#### **EMT Course Sequence**

- 8333 Emergency Medical Technician I
- 8334 Emergency Medical Technician II
- 8335 Emergency Medical Technician III
- The EMT program prepares students for a variety of careers and advanced coursework in the healthcare field including service as a paramedic.
  - Become skilled in identifying and dealing with emergencies such as bleeding, fractures, airway obstruction, and cardiac arrest.
  - Learn proper care and use of common emergency equipment and safe methods for lifting, moving, and transporting injured persons
- Opportunity to earn EMT certification

#### **Application**

- First round notifications February 5, 2024
- First selection deadline February 21, 2024
- Log into your <u>account</u> to accept one offer
- Click "View Submitted Applications"
- Accepting an offer declines all other offers including wait list offers
- Offers after Feb 6 or later will have 16 days after the date of to accept or decline.

#### **Transportation**

- Any rising 9th or 10th grade student that accepts an offer to attend a specialty center or program pathway will be required to transfer to the offering school
- Rising 11th and 12th grade students may choose to travel to their program
- Transportation is provided between the home and school or between schools

#### **Additional Information**

- Students who transfer become full time members of that school including VHSL eligibility including clubs, sports and activities
- Students who leave a Center or program will be required to return to their zoned high school
- Students wishing to transfer into a different pathway at their
   Center may make that request if space is available
- Scheduling will be completed by the Center Counseling team
