Program Overview

- Nurse Aide I / 2 credits
 - (2 class blocks meeting every day for first semester)
- Nurse Aide II / 2 credits
 - (2 class blocks meeting every day for second semester)



Program Overview

- Social Security Number
- Immunization Records
 - TB/Flu shot
 - Negative drug screen
- Uniforms (apron, white shoes (no logos) analog watch)
- 1:10 student/teacher ratio for clinicals
- 140 hours met prior to certification
 - o 100 hours of instructional seat time
 - 40 hours of clinical
- Program is governed by the VA Board of Nursing Requirements



Nurse Aide Course Sequence

- 8360 Nurse Aide I
- 8362 Nurse Aide II
- Skills obtained in a variety of health care facilities under the supervision of an instructor to include -
 - Infection-control,
 - Safety and emergency procedures,
 - Recognition of changes in body functioning,
 - Personal care needs of both the long-term care and acute care patient
- Opportunity to earn Certified Nurse Aide Examination : Virginia Board of Nursing

Application

- First round notifications February 5, 2024
- First selection deadline February 21, 2024
- Log into your <u>account</u> to accept one offer
- Click "View Submitted Applications"
- Accepting an offer declines all other offers including wait list offers
- Offers after Feb 6 or later will have 16 days after the date of to accept or decline.

Transportation

- Any rising 9th or 10th grade student that accepts an offer to attend a specialty center or program pathway will be required to transfer to the offering school
- Rising 11th and 12th grade students may choose to travel to their program
- Transportation is provided between the home and school or between schools

Additional Information

- Students who transfer become full time members of that school including VHSL eligibility including clubs, sports and activities
- Students who leave a Center or program will be required to return to their zoned high school
- Students wishing to transfer into a different pathway at their
 Center may make that request if space is available
- Scheduling will be completed by the Center Counseling team
